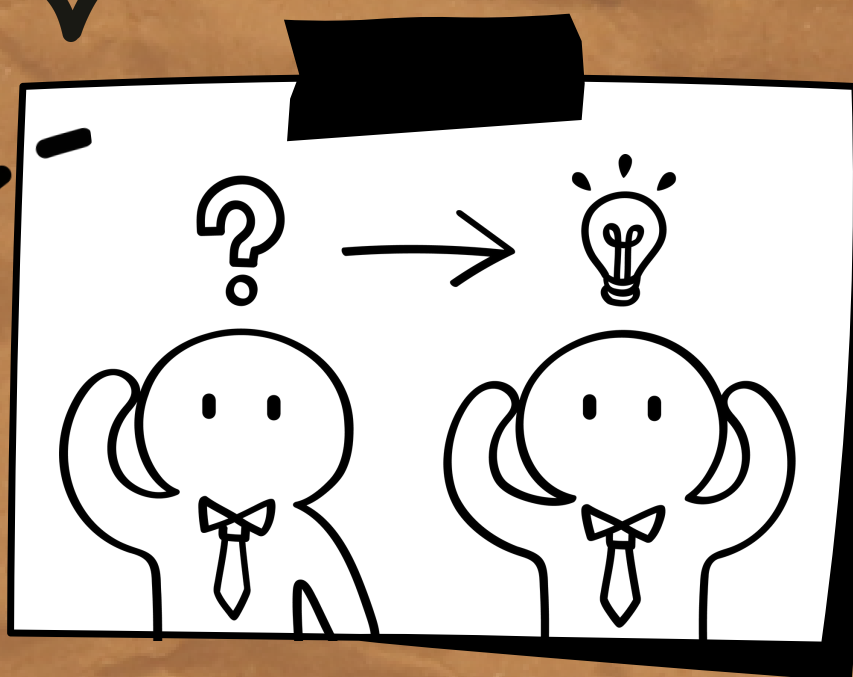
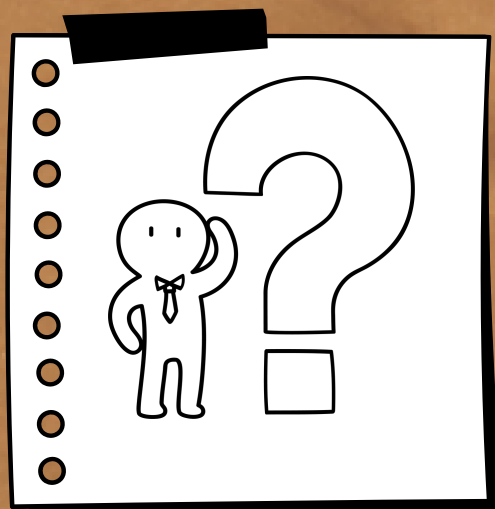

IDEAS

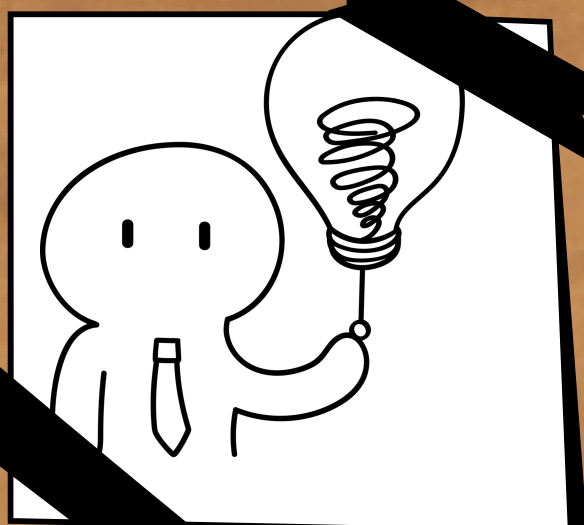
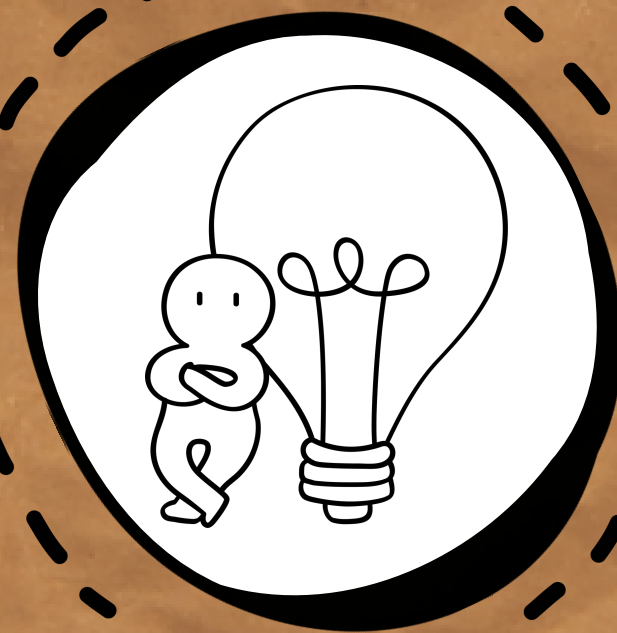
Be realistic

If no school is named in Section I of the EHC plan, the Local Authority should provide EOTAS, you will need to get this written into the EHCP.



REMEMBER

An EOTAS arrangement can be temporary, subject to annual reviews, and may be withdrawn if a suitable school is identified.
